Sensory Trail – Public Consultation & Open Day at The Hub, Saturday 12th November

During the Platinum Jubilee long weekend, funds were raised to move forward with a possible sensory trail utilising the perimeter of the Bishops Hull Playing Field. The funds allowed for the creation of an initial plan that was presented to the Trustees of the Village Hall & Playing Field Trust (VH&PFT) at their AGM. The proposal does not impact on the playing surface for cricket or football. Therefore, the VH&PFT agreed to the proposal being put forward for public consultation, to gauge the interest of the local Community. The proposal includes feature areas that would be developed in phases linked together with sensory planting. Phase one of the project would include an accessible path, with separate steps, to allow easy access between the top path and the lower-level path that links the cricket pavilions and The Hub. The plans will be available for inspection at The Hub on Saturday 12th November from 11:00am until 2:00 pm. We will also be there to answer any questions you may have. The plans will then be on public display on the Village website, Facebook page and notice boards around the village. If there is sufficient support, we move forward to raising funds, initially for detailed plans and then for the actual construction work. Netherclay Woodland - The Environment Agency will be undertaking works at Bishops Hull Gauge Station off Netherclay from week commencing 24th October 2022 until mid-January 2023. Objectives of the works are threefold. 1. Improvements will be made to the weir to facilitate fish and eel passage upstream, including reducing the height of part of the weir and installing an eel pass. 2. The lowering of part of the weir will also improve the quality of the data collected at times of low water flow. 3. The gauge station hut will be replaced with a new structure that is more secure and includes some biodiversity enhancements, such as a green roof and bird boxes. In order to facilitate the works, the Agency will require the use of an area within the community woodland area for parking, a materials store and a welfare unit location. This area will be heras fenced and located on the grassed area. The access near the bridge and footpaths across the site will remain open, but will be managed by the Agency's contractor to ensure everybody's safety. It would be much appreciated if access to the community woodland could be taken by an alternative route to minimise footfall in this area. We would also like to make the community aware that the Agency's contractor will need to bring a 20-tonne excavator through the village to the gauge station, where it will remain for the majority duration of the works. A specific time frame of when the excavator will be arriving at site will be communicated in due course.

Netherclay Community Woodland LNR - The volunteers have started back at the Woodland, on a Tuesday morning from 9:30 to 11:30 with a coffee break about mid-way through. So far in 2022 we have planted Spring flowering bulbs, sown wildflower seeds, coppiced a hedge, developed new habitat areas and maintained others. A big project was to develop a 10-year Management Plan. This has now been completed and we await feedback from the Forestry Commission. Netherclay Footbridge - Many of you will remember, back in April last year, when I announced that our Iron Bridge was to be refurbished and that work would begin in the Summer of 2022. Clearly that didn't happen, much to the understandable frustration of several local residents, including myself. We all deserve an explanation from Somerset County Council, so I contacted the Right of Way team and asked them to write to me with their reasons the work had not taken place. Here is the email from the Rights of Way Warden for Bridges:

"As discussed, it was our intention to progress restoration works of the footbridge during the summer this year but this was unfortunately delayed. As you are aware the footbridge sits on a programme of works on bridges across the County with the works at Netherclay footbridge being allocated to me in late 2021. I already had bridge replacements at Norton Fitzwarren and Wick allocated which were higher up the programme than Netherclay and unfortunately the works to replace these other bridges were delayed due to a number of reasons but mainly due to procurement issues associated with global availability of steel and timber. Although these bridges were replaced this year there was a knock-on effect to me remaining projects."

"Notwithstanding this delay, we did proceed with the preliminary works which would have been necessary to allow the restoration this year including tree felling, vegetation clearance and bat mitigation works as well as consultation with the Environment Agency and South West Heritage Trust. Unfortunately, during these preliminary works, birds were recorded nesting within one of the bridge piers and this finally precluded restoration being undertaken this year as hoped. As discussed, I have already taken further advice from our appointed ecologist to minimise the chance of this occurring again next year."

"I am conscious of how sensitive the reopening of this bridge is with members of the public and I can assure you that these works are a priority for both myself and the Rights of Way service as a whole. Given the various defects present on the current bridge, the restoration is going to be of a complex nature and I will shortly be meeting with our structures team to discuss engineering support for the works; once I have had this meeting, I will contact you again regarding an update."

As your County/Unitary Councillor, I will continue to push for 'our' bridge to re-opened as soon as possible.
