Purchased in 2003 with contributions from Entrust & Bishops Hull Parish Council – owned by TDBC

Woodland planted 2003 – to Forestry Commission standards.

Over 7,000 trees and shrubs planted.

Objectives

To provide an improved habitat for wildlife

To slow the rate of local rainwater runoff, thereby reducing flood risk further downstream.

To be an attractive amenity for the quiet enjoyment of the local community



Timeline

Maintained for 4 years by private contractor

Paths cut – 4 times a year - TDBC

- FWAG helped us to create the document
- £1,000 grant paid for this.



Countryside Stewardship Higher Tier

- Major project 2023
- FWAG created the document
- Extension of the Woodland Management Plan.
- Community Involvement educational visits
- Grant of £1,000 p.a. for next 5 years
- FINANCIAL POSITION
- £2,280 in the bank
- Insurance due shortly
- No grant from the PC last year
- Sale of logs so far has raised £540.
